

PIZZA FOR LUNCH PROGRAM

Nutritional Requirements

- Papa John's will provide pizzas that meet the National School Lunch Program requirements, established by the USDA, for bread/bread alternate, meat/meat alternate for grades 4-12. *(The requirements may differ in your market, therefore, please confirm).*

Papa John's will provide the following:

- Deliver hot, fresh pizzas to your school cafeteria within ten minutes of selling time.
- Provide you with monthly statements reflecting sales information.
- Allow orders to be placed up to one hour prior to delivery.
